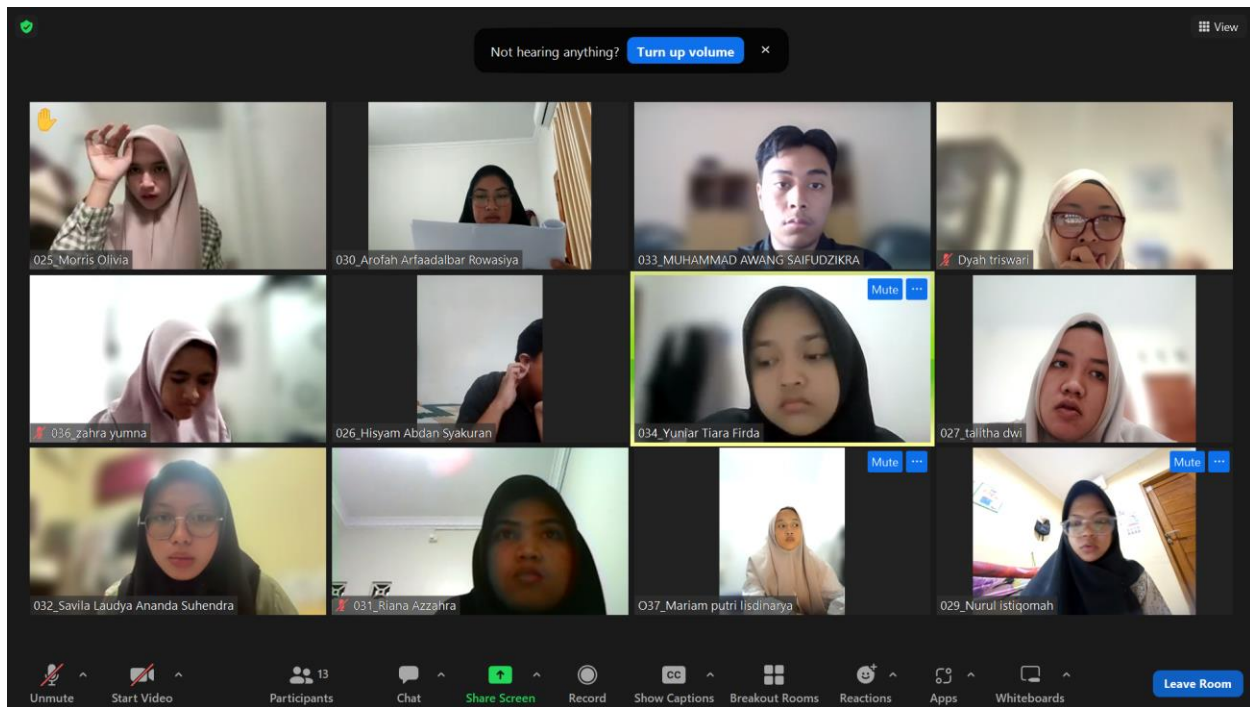

II. Problem analysis

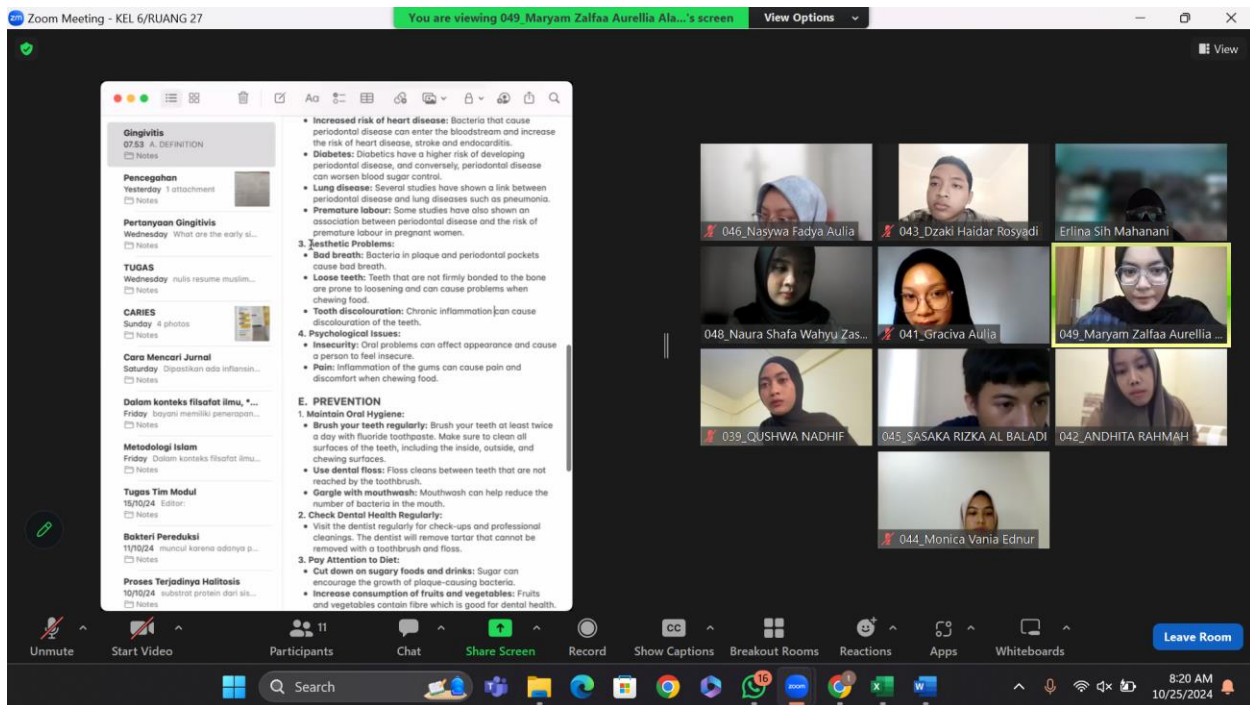
1. Gingivitis is caused by inflammatory condition of the gingival tissue, most commonly caused by bacterial infection.

- Increased risk of heart disease: Bacteria that cause periodontal disease can enter the bloodstream and increase the risk of heart disease, stroke and endocarditis.
- Diabetes: Diabetics have a higher risk of developing periodontal disease, and conversely, periodontal disease can worsen blood sugar control.
- Lung disease: Several studies have shown a link between periodontal disease and lung diseases such as pneumonia.
- Premature labour: Some studies have also shown an association between periodontal disease and the risk of premature labour in pregnant women.

3. Aesthetic Problems:

- Bad breath: Bacteria in plaque and periodontal pockets cause bad breath.
- Loose teeth: Teeth that are not firmly bonded to the bone are prone to loosening and can cause problems when chewing food.
- Tooth discolouration: Chronic inflammation can cause discolouration of the teeth.

4. Psychological issues:

- Insecurity: Oral problems can affect appearance and cause a person to feel insecure.
- Pain: Inflammation of the gums can cause pain and discomfort when chewing food.

E. PREVENTION

1. Maintain Oral Hygiene:
 - Brush your teeth regularly: Brush your teeth at least twice a day with fluoride toothpaste. Make sure to clean all surfaces of the teeth, including the inside, outside, and chewing surfaces.
 - Use dental floss: Floss cleans between teeth that are not reached by the toothbrush.
 - Gargle with mouthwash: Mouthwash can help reduce the number of bacteria in the mouth.
2. Check Dental Health Regularly:
 - Visit the dentist regularly for check-ups and professional cleanings. The dentist will remove tartar that cannot be removed with a toothbrush and floss.
3. Pay Attention to Diet:
 - Cut down on sugary foods and drinks: Sugar can encourage the growth of plaque-causing bacteria.
 - Increase consumption of fruits and vegetables: Fruits and vegetables contain fibre which is good for dental health.
